Summary of the activity	In this workshop, participants will create their own virtual galleries showcasing the results of their artistic endeavours. They will incorporate a variety of media, including visual art, music, and interactive elements, to curate a rich and dynamic experience. Participants will also design guided tours to lead visitors through their galleries, highlighting key pieces and the stories behind them. Through this process, they will learn how to present their work in a professional and

	<p>engaging format, utilizing digital tools to enhance the viewer's experience.</p> <p>Once the galleries are complete, participants will have the opportunity to visit and explore the virtual exhibitions created by their peers. They will engage with interactive exhibits, delve into artefacts, and listen to the stories that breathe life into each piece. Through collaborative exploration, participants will gain insights into diverse artistic perspectives and approaches to digital curation.</p> <p>To maximize the impact of their work, participants will be encouraged to share their virtual galleries online, making their creative output accessible to a broader audience. They will also explore embedding their galleries into websites, thereby integrating their projects into professional or educational contexts. This workshop not only fosters creativity and technical skills but also empowers participants to curate, present, and promote their artistic achievements through innovative virtual spaces.</p>
Methodology and procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Choose content: select the images, videos, 3D objects, and texts you want to include in your exhibition.</li> <li>2. Design the exhibition space: choose the overall design and layout of your virtual exhibition hall.</li> <li>3. Construct the space: build and arrange the walls and spaces to shape the flow of the exhibition.</li> <li>4. Place artefacts: position your selected artefacts at the desired locations within the gallery.</li> <li>5. Plan the guided tour: map out the visitor journey through the exhibition, highlighting key pieces.</li> <li>6. Publish and Share: Once finalized, publish your gallery and share it with your audience.</li> </ol>
